



South Gloucestershire Harmful Sexual Behaviour Service

OnTrack is a specialist service offering intervention directed at managing the risk and presenting difficulties of young individuals that have engaged in harmful sexual behaviour.

We work with:

- Individuals between 12-18 years old, who have been referred via their allocated social worker.
- Individuals with an assigned social worker during the duration of their intervention with OnTrack (ensuring that the intervention remains funded).
- Individuals who are no longer under police investigation.

We provide:

- Consultation prior to referral (we can support professionals to determine whether their young person requires a referral to OnTrack, or sign post them to a more appropriate service).
- Resources for parents, professionals and young people to support them to make positive choices relating to their HSB (e.g., consent, safe websites).
- Tailored training to professionals dealing with individuals concerned in HSB.

We will:

- Complete an AIM Risk assessment, in order to inform the intervention plan.
- Deliver 1-1 intervention with the young person to address their HSB and associated difficulties.
- Provide recommendations for further intervention that may be sought after the intervention with OnTrack has been completed.
- Provide recommendations for both the young person and those that support them, including ways to best support their engagement in intervention and managing their risk long term.

For young people that are currently under police investigation for their HSB, we remain available to consult with their assigned professionals to support the development of safety plans and to signpost additional support that may be available whilst the investigation is ongoing.
