Yoti CitizenCard - 16 and 17-year-olds in Bucks can get discounted bus travel with a Yoti CitizenCard. This proof of age card allows you to travel on some buses within Buckinghamshire for a reduced single fare.



Albert Kennedy Trust | LGBTQ+ Youth Homelessness Charity - The Albert Kennedy Trust are the national LGBTQ + youth homelessness charity, focused on prevention and early action. They provide safe homes, mentoring, training, advocacy and support to young people who are homeless or living in a hostile environment after coming out to their parents, care givers and peers.



Youth Enquiry Service (YES) - free and confidential support, information and counselling to 13 to 25 year olds in the High Wycombe area.



Switch Bucks - Switch offers support and information, and helps young people to develop life skills to make healthy choices around their alcohol and drug use - choices which are important to them.



Aylesbury Nightstop (emergency accommodation for young people) - Youth Concern (Aylesbury) is proud to have launched Aylesbury Nightstop which offers emergency host accommodation to young people aged 16 to 25 years old facing a homelessness crisis, thereby preventing entrenched issues developing.



Youth Concern Drop-in Centre (Aylesbury) - drop-in centre in Whitehill Lane offers young people a safe place to meet and access support, guidance and counselling. They have excellent on-site facilities including an IT suite and a purpose-built in-house Music Studio with high specification equipment and software.



Community Youth Ventures C.I.C. - community interest company that focuses on inspiring young lives through innovative and diversionary activities. Their aim is to empower young people to make positive choices, enhance their opportunities and widen their horizons including the impact and support within the community around them.

Filters

Filters help you to refine your results by location, age range, free or low cost, and by SEND Needs. Filters appear in the left-hand side on a desktop computer and just above results on a mobile.


Ticking a filter will automatically refine the results and the number of matches returned will show in brackets beside it. As you filter your results, filters that have no corresponding matches will disappear making it easy to see the breaths of services, organisations and activities available. An A to Z bar at the bottom of the website also lets you jump to activities, services and organisation by name.



Good to know: From the town list, you can filter by Nationwide and Buckinghamshire - wide to find national services and organisations - these results can then compliment results for a specific town

Shortlists

Advice pages, services, organisations and activities can be added to custom shortlists to view later, share or print. To do this simply click the '+ Add to My Favourites' button that appears on records and pages. By emailing shortlists to yourself, you'll receive a link to those results that can be shared or used as a hyperlink.
