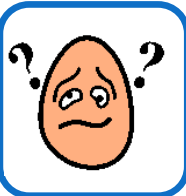
What we can do



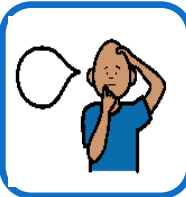
Help people by talking to them and their carers

Help if you have a mental health problem



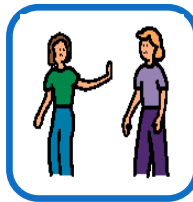
Help if you or someone else is worried about your memory

Help if you are hurting yourself or other people



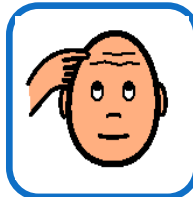
Help if you have problems getting on with others

Help if there are problems with the people who help you

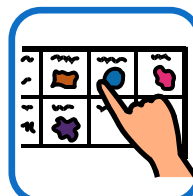


Help to work out which bits of thinking you are good and not so good at

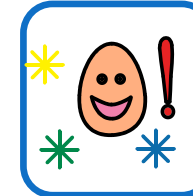

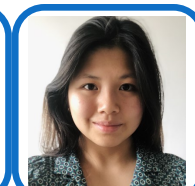
