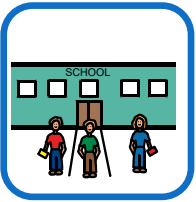

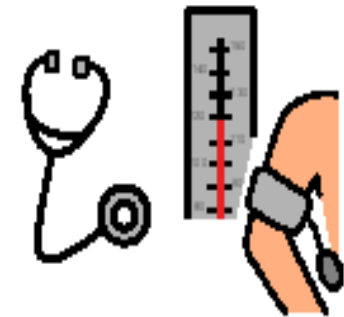

Help you to understand about your health and keeping healthy



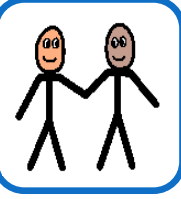
Help you to get the best out of your health appointments

We work with the Acute Liaison Nurse if you go to hospital and need more help

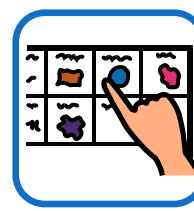

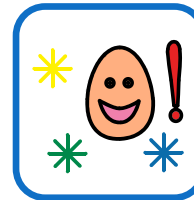

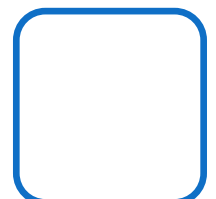
