

Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE) Information Sharing Form

This process should not be used to report concerns that a child may be at risk of harm and/or immediate danger. The process for reporting concerns about a specific child can be found here:

This process should be used to share non-urgent information which you believe may be connected to CSE.

All professionals and volunteers in Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland have a duty to protect children from sexual abuse and exploitation including passing on non-urgent relevant information. This information is very important and will help the Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland Multi-Agency CSE team build intelligence about child sexual exploitation and better target the response to prevent and disrupt CSE. The information may include:

- Vehicle details including registration numbers, make, model and colour
- Details or descriptions of suspected perpetrators – names, phone numbers, addresses
- Details of unusual or regular callers to a children's home
- Third party information e.g. rumours or concerns about people or locations
