

# Guidance for Agencies Receiving CSE/Sexual Exploitation Information.

Information Received

Is a child or vulnerable adult at risk of sexual exploitation

Yes, child/vulnerable adult is at risk now

Telephone Police on 999 or 101, and refer to Children's Social Care 0191 2772500 or Adult Social Care 0191 278 8377 Immediately.

Yes, but the risk is not immediate

Make safeguarding referral to Children's Social Care 0191 2772500 or Adult Social Care 0191 278 8377 who will consider informing Police

Practitioner would appreciate further guidance from Children's or Adults Social Care or Police specialist

No child or vulnerable adult is identified, but other information about CSE or sexual exploitation is known
