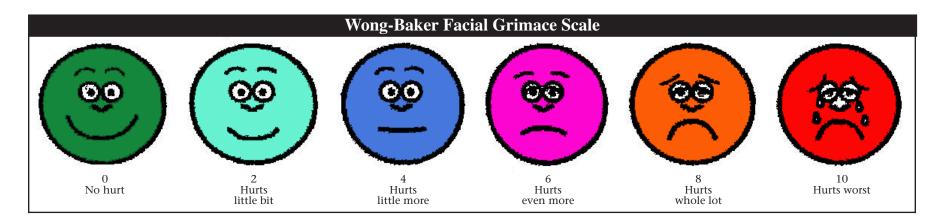
Universal Pain Assessment Tool
