



## **Domestic Abuse Risk Assessment for Children**

This Domestic Abuse Risk Assessment for Children (DARAC) tool can be used by professionals who are undertaking an assessment of the risks to children living in a home where domestic violence has already been identified. They should have undertaken the training provided by Barnardo's in how to administer and interpret the tool.

DARAC has been developed to help practitioners:

- identify risks to children from domestic abuse and begin the risk assessment process
- decide whether a case needs a safeguarding response or family support
- identify appropriate interventions for the children, the nonabusing parent and the abusive perpetrator
