How We Can Help You

The Independent Visitor Service brings children and young people toegther with an adult who wil take an interest in their life and regularly spend time with them.

We select all of our volunteers carefully and train them to make sure they are someone you can trust and look forward to seeing.

They can help you by:

- spending time with you seperate from carers and adults you already know
- choosing activities together such as something you have always wanted to try or something that you like doing
- giving you opportunities to try new activities and go to new places
- listening to you and providing support and friendship
- if you would like them to your Independent Visitor can also attend review meetings with you

Who We Are!

The Independent Visitor Service is one of the projects within the North East Children's Rights Service. We have a team of professional staff and trained volunteers.

What will happen?

If you and your social worker think that you will benefit from an Independent Visitor then your social worker will make a referral to us. We will talk to you to explain what we do and see if this is something that you might be interested in. If you want to go ahead we will begin our matching process.

Part of this process involves us giving you a booklet to fill in which tells us about the things that you like doing. You will receive a booklet telling you about the Independent Visitor and the things that they like doing before you meet them to make sure you still want to go ahead.

Your first meeting with your Independent Visitor will be somewhere that you feel safe. You will decide together where to go next and what you would like to do.
