







CLA to CiN

Within the Child Looked After element from the map, click on the **Decisions** tab. You will see a variety of outcomes. Click the **Start** button next to **End CLA (Finalise CLA Care Plan)**.



Please note that if the care plan hasn't been updated (blue on the map) then the option to end CLA will be greyed out and you will be unable to select it until you have updated the care plan.






Enter in a date of initiation and a reason for the decision then click on the **Confirm** button.

The task to end CLA goes to your manager.

Once your manager has completed their part, you will receive a task. Click on this.



Click on the **Decisions** tab.

Task Description

Under the **Outcomes** heading, click on the **Start** (or **Restart**, depending on the circumstance) button next to **Return to Family (Provision of Services)**.

The CLA icon under the child's name should now display a line through it to acknowldge it has been completed and the CiN icon will be present.
