Communicating carefully; communicates care.

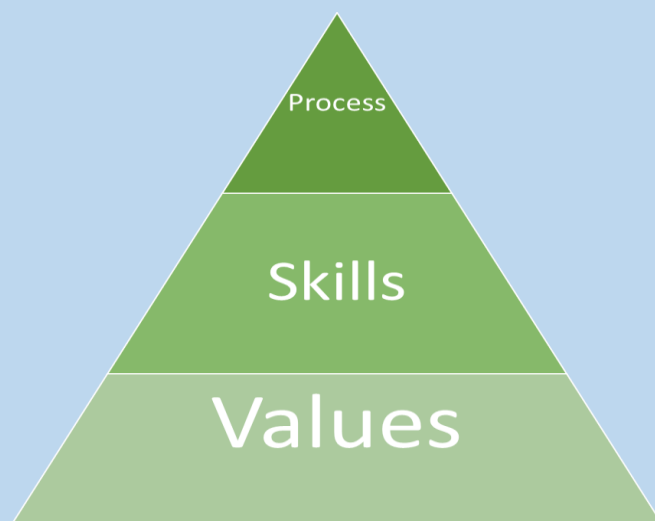
Providing guidance for PERSPECTIVE what is happening, IMPACT who has been affected and how, as well as SOLUTIONS what needs to happen now, what support is needed.

There will be an opportunity to reflect and feedback about the meeting at the end.

There will be a review after this meeting for ongoing support or the success of strengthening stability.

The group introduces who they are and why they are here? If the child/children are not present, how have their views been gained.
