If young person is identified by Social Worker as 'Edge of Care' referral made to Supporting Solutions



Social Worker completed CAPVA Screening Tool is shared with Supporting Solutions Manager

Supporting Solutions Team manger to consider co-delivery with Harbour if situation is deemed high risk/or wider domestic abuse is identified

Supporting Solutions CAPVA workers allocated by Team Manager

If Harbour support is deemed necessary

Parent Support Officer or -Victim Liaison Officers to work with Parent/carer

Delivery Team Worker to work with young person



If HARBOUR support deemed necessary i.e. High Risk cases or where support from partners is needed to deliver RYPP (Capacity / expected timescale for involvement of YJS less than 12 weeks) Case Manager to discuss with OPS CAPVA Lead via
