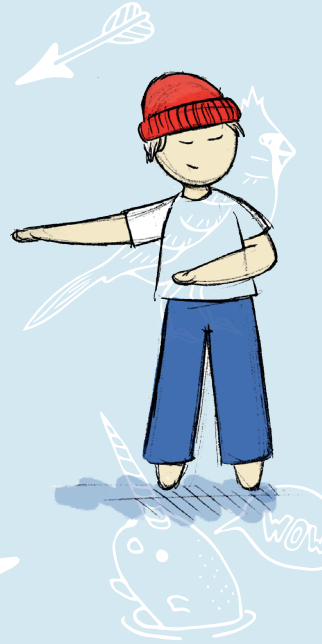
What the group do
