- Mind of My Own One App AND Express
 can be used with and by children and
 young people aged 3-25 who are open to
 Social Care, Early Help and who are from
 families who foster.
- It's fantastic for children and young people to give their views and life experiences for their Assessments, Plans, Reviews, Meetings or Conferences.
- They can contact you to let you know how they are feeling, if they have a problem, and if they want to talk to you, in between seeing them.
- It's also great to use with a child or young person to get to know them and for them to get to know you, building relationships.
- Mind of My Own can be translated into over 120 different languages!
- A Mind of My Own statement created by a child or young person is part of their life story, in their own words, their own views at a point in time, their own experiences and they can read these if they access their files.
