

## MOVING UP THE BED 4-WAY BED SYSTEM 1 CARER

- Carer to stand at a 45° angle, with one foot in front of the other.
- Carer to grasp top sheet.

- Carer to transfer weight from the front to back foot. Hands to remain on bed throughout movement.

  Keep movements small. Do **not** be tempted to move the person up the bed in one movement.
- Carer to move to the opposite side of the bed and repeat this process until person has been moved up the bed.







- **N.B.** Ensure bed is at appropriate height for carer.
  - If bed side rails are in situ, lower prior to rolling person on bed.
  - Tuck top sheet under mattress after positioning.
