## MOVING UP THE BED SLIDE SHEET 1 CARER

- Carer to fit slide sheet underneath person.
  Refer to Moving and Handling Care Plan for technique.
- Carer to stand at shoulder position with one foot in front of the other.
- Carer to grasp top sheet near person's shoulder.
  Carer to transfer weight from to back foot.
  Hands to remain on bed throughout
  movement. Keep movements small. Do **not** be tempted to move the person up the bed in one movement.
- Carer to move to opposite side of bed and repeat process until person has been moved up the bed.
- If required, Carer to move to persons hips and knees and repeat process to ensure that person is lying straight.
- Carer to remove slide sheet; grasping the bottom sheet, and pulling it inside out.



- N.B.
   If bed side rails are in situ, ensure that they are lowered on side of carer, opposite side maybe raised to provide reassurance.
  - Ensure bed is at appropriate height for carer.
