

MOVING ACROSS THE BED

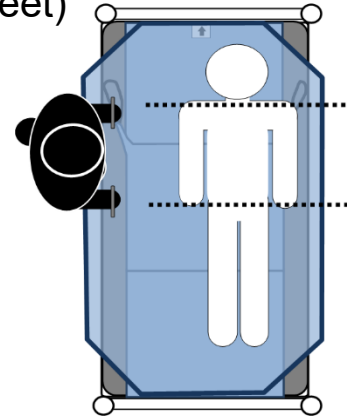

PADDED 4-WAY BED MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

1 CARER

1

Carer to raise 'curtain' (middle section of base sheet) as per guidance sheet B27.



2

Carer to stand at shoulder position.

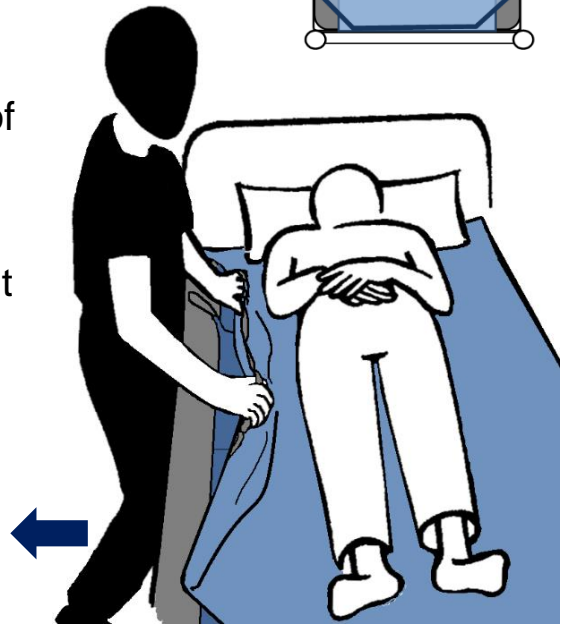
Carer to lift top sheet and grasp handles of top sheet, at person's shoulder and hip level.

3

Carer to stand with one foot in front of the other.

Carer to transfer weight from the front to back foot.

Keep movements small, do **not** be tempted to move the person in one movement.



4

Carer to move further down the bed, and repeat process at hips, and feet until desired position is achieved.

5

After desired positioning is reached.

Carer to lower 'curtain' (middle section of base sheet) as per guidance sheet B27.



- N.B.**
- Bed side rails to be lowered prior to re-positioning on bed.
 - Ensure bed is at appropriate height for carer.
