


YOUR GUIDE TO FOSTER CARE

MY FOSTER CARER IS:


They look after me.

MY SOCIAL WORKER IS:


It is their job to visit me, make sure I am well looked after, and to talk to me.



WHEN WILL I SEE MY FAMILY?

When you live in a foster home, it doesn't mean that you wont see your family.

Your Foster Carer and Social Worker will speak to you about this.

HOW LONG WILL I HAVE TO STAY?

Your Social Worker will make a 'Care Plan' for you. This tells you and everyone close to you what is going to happen. Your social worker will ask you what you think should be in your plan
