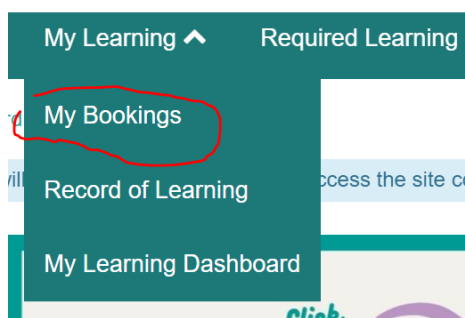
MyLearning

MyLearning is Wokingham Borough Council's Learning Management System (LMS) which supports the self-service booking processes and recording of most learning opportunities available to our staff and partners. It is internet based, allowing you to access it anytime, anywhere and from any mobile device. You do not need to be connected to the WBC network or using a WBC device. Points to note when using MyLearning

- **Bookings** Upon booking you will receive an email confirmation and any related joining links from noreply@learningpool.com. This email will also provide you with the option of adding the event to your Outlook calendar which is recommended. A reminder of your booking will be sent around 5 days prior to the event.

- Online bookings are closed 7 days prior to an event. If spaces are available, late bookings can be made by emailing: HREnquiries@wokingham.gov.uk to request a space.
- **Cancellations** If you need to cancel your booking please log into your account and cancel your place. A quick way to access the course is via the “My Bookings” section which is located under the “My Learning” menu at the top of your home page (see below). It lists any courses you are currently booked to attend and by clicking on the course you will be able cancel your booking if more than 7 days before the event.



If online booking for the event has already closed (normally 7 days before the event) you will not be able to cancel the booking yourself and will need to contact HREnquiries@wokingham.gov.uk to ask them to remove you from the session. **Please note you will need to provide a reason for the late cancellation.**

Me Learning – Mosaic Training

Mosaic training is managed by the Systems Support Team. Despite the similarity in names, please note that this is separate to any training provided via MyLearning. New staff needing Mosaic access will be contacted and set up for the Me Learning training automatically.

Capita One Training

The Systems Support Team can also provide training for new users of Capita One. This is provided via Teams on a 1:1 basis or in small groups.

Funding is limited so managers/service managers must ensure training is relevant and provide authorisation prior to submitting the request.
