Concerns that a child or young person is at risk of CSE, CCE or missing? If Yes -Practitioner completes CE risk assessment in Mosaic workstep (from start menu)

Practitioner sends completed CE tool to Team Manager for sign off. If scored MED or HIGH Risk , Team Manager to send to CST Inbox for threshold discussion with police.

CST Inbox- reviews all submitted CE risk assessment tools. All MED & HIGH children scheduled for discussion at 'threshold meeting'

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Threshold Meeting held with Safeguarding Hub (SGH) Police and CSC to agree on risk level from CE tool. Outcome and minutes of discussion are added to CE risk assessment along with any recommended actions.

Outcome of Threshold Meeting - Does the child / young person meet the threshold for allocation within the Safeguarding Hub? (police team that manages CE/ CSE)

High Risk

1. Child/YP is allocated a SGH police to work alongside practitioner.

2. High Risk of Harm (HROH) meeting, chaired by a Service Manager. is arranged by MET admin. Practitioner to complete briefing 72hrs prior to HROH in SharePoint document sent in invite.

3. Child/ YPs name added to MET tracker by MET admin for monthly multi-agency tracking/ awareness until risk reduced to MED via HROH



HROH Meetings occurs every 6 weeks maximum until professionals agree risk is reduced to **Medium.**

CE screening to be updated 3 monthly until risk reduced to low.

Medium Risk

1. Where required, child/ YP may be allocated a named Neighbourhood Police Team officer (NP/ Missing police officer) as link worker

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2, Child to continue to be managed via existing plan, i.e. CIN, Core Group or Child Looked After process



CE screening tool to be reviewed (min of 3 monthly) until evidence of reduction of risk to low.

Repeat process above.
